      - Students must take a fruit or juice with their breakfast entrée for the meal to qualify as a complete meal and to qualify as FREE.

- 3. Teachers Report (S. Nye & K. Ventimiglia)
  - <u>Kindergarten</u> Learning school expectations and routines, managing their personal belongings independently, also learning the names of classmates by singing name songs and playing rhyming name games.
  - <u>1st</u> Working on reading and spelling short vowel, learning good reader habits, math reviewing partnerships up to 10.
  - 2nd Learning about our community, writing beginning to plan and write small moment stories. Reading working to build reading stamina.
  - <u>3rd</u> Working with and building classroom expectations. We are r highlighting the State of Michigan in preparation for the Lansing field trip on Tuesday, Sep 26th.
